(問1)

- He can access his calendar on all of his devices.

(問3)

(解答例 1) I would prefer a paper calendar. Writing down my schedule and notes is, for me, much quicker than taking out my phone and typing. I may also get distracted and use TikTok instead of using my calendar app. In that sense, I prefer James's wall calendar to Nick's Apple Calendar. (50 words)

(解答例 2) I would prefer using an app. Like Nick, I like how it reminds me of my appointments and how I can access my calendar on either my phone or computer. Another reason I prefer an app is that we can share calendars. For example, my homework assignments appear on my calendar because my teacher schedules them on a Google calendar which I also access. (64 words)

(解答例 3) When at home, I would prefer to have a big wall calendar. That would give me a really good overview of my schedule. However, when I am on the move, I would prefer to use a calendar app on my phone rather than a diary. That would make it easy to quickly check my schedule when I don't have a bag to carry a diary in. (66 words)

Small children could even plant vegetables in the schoolyard. (71 words)

(解答例 2) I recommend removing CO₂ from the air by planting trees and, at the same time, storing CO₂ emissions from factories deep underground. These solutions seem more realistic and also less harmful to our planet. They may not be able to completely solve the problem; however, they may give us time to develop other geoengineering solutions or new clean sources of energy. (61 words)

(解答例 1) I'd really like to take part in the two-week language learning program in Australia, and I need your help. I really need to go for a study abroad program now because my teacher told me that my experience will be especially useful after I come back. I want to do well at university, and I think this experience would give me confidence and stronger motivation to study English in university. Also, my university offers a one-year study-abroad program in Canberra, which is funded by the university. If I go on this two-week program now, I'm positive that I would learn a lot more in the one-year program, because I would have gotten used to Australian English. (116 words)

In addition to that, I would learn different ways of looking at things by experiencing another culture. Finally, staying in another country would give me a lot of confidence. I think all of these things would help me to be successful in my future career. By being successful in my future career, I hope to make you proud. (110 words)

I have saved enough money for the program, but I do not have enough to pay for the plane ticket. Could you possibly help out with that? (117 words)

(解答例4)

I have a strong hope to be an English teacher in the future. I, however, do not have enough ability and courage to speak English in front of many students. Improving my English skill is required, and communicating with many English native speakers is very important for me. In Japanese classrooms, there are few opportunities to talk with any English natives. I have one more important reason for wanting to go to Australia. As you know, I am an animal lover and am interested in animal protection. Seeing many koalas being rescued from forest fires has inspired me to get involved in this field of work. Australia is the best place for me to further my studies in this area. (120 words)
