### ○ Outline of the course

#### ① Japanese language education

\*According to the result of Japanese language placement test at the first day of each semester, we recommend some Japanese language classes to each student.

#### • Japanese language (five classes per a week)

Advanced level (four classes per a week)

Intermediate level (one class per a week)

#### • Supplementary Japanese course (five classes per a week)

Reading, Kanji for students not familiar with Chinese characters, and Basic Japanese Course, etc.

#### ② Specialized training 【12-month or 18-month courses】

##### (a) Pedagogical training

Tutorials and auditing of regular classes of the university, field trips to primary, junior-high and other educational institutions, and lectures and seminars in the university.

##### (b) Subjects or courses taught in English

Courses offered by the English Education, Science Education, and Special Education Departments are partly taught in English.

#### ③ Researching with Japanese students.

TT students take almost all of the classes for Japanese students. And we offer you to research with your tutor students.

#### ④ Interacting with citizens, visiting educational institutions, experiencing Japanese culture, etc.

Students have opportunities to participate in community events.

They can enjoy and experience Japanese culture through those events , such as a moon-viewing at a nursery school and rice-cake making in winter.
