– Japanese language education

According to the result of a Japanese language placement test on the first day of each semester, we recommend some Japanese language classes to each student.

- Japanese language (five classes per week)
Advanced level (four classes per week)
Intermediate level (one class per week)
- Supplementary Japanese course (five classes per a week)
Reading, Kanji for students not familiar with Chinese characters, and Basic Japanese Course, etc.

– Specialized training 【12 month or 18 month courses】

Pedagogical training

Tutorials and auditing of regular classes of the university, field trips to primary, junior high and other educational institutions, and lectures and seminars in the university.

- Interacting with citizens, visiting educational institutions, experiencing Japanese culture, etc.

Students have opportunities to participate in community events. They can enjoy and experience Japanese culture through those events, such as a moon viewing at a nursery school and rice cake making in winter.
